

PE and SPORT FUNDING 2021-2022

Grindon Infant School Allocation of Funds

For the year 2021-2022 we have been allocated **£ 17010.00** for the development of PE and sport to promote fitness, healthy living and wellbeing. We also have a carry-over amount of **£ 7025.67** from the year 2020-2021 which was unable to be spent due to school closures. We offer a PE sessions within school to all year groups including nursery. In previous years, this funding has generally been used to provide sports clubs on afternoons at 3:15-4:15pm, including football, swimming and volleyball and for additional Coaches to come in to school in order that the children can have the opportunities to try physical activities that they may not previously have had the opportunity to do so. This has included yoga, judo and skate and scoot sessions. In 2021-2022, we are aiming to develop the physical activities that our children will complete, although these sessions will take place in line with our School Risk Assessment in Autumn term. This year we will take the opportunity to further develop our P.E provision to promote physical fitness and health living in unstructured times including breaks and lunchtime. The table below sets out what we aim to provide at Grindon Infant School through the Sports funding we will receive this year.
