Area of Learning	Focus
<b>Literacy</b>  <b>COMPREHENSION</b>	<p><b>Comprehension:</b>            Correctly sequence a story or event using pictures and/or captions.            Respond to questions about how and why something is happening.            Know the difference between different types of texts (fiction, nonfiction, poetry)            Play influenced by experience of books-gestures and actions used to act out a story, event or rhyme from text or illustrations.</p>
<b>Literacy</b>  <b>WORD READING</b>	<p><b>Word Reading:</b>            Read some letter groups that each represent one sound and say sounds for them.            Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter-sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few exception words.</p>
<b>PHONICS</b>	<p><b>Phase 3</b>            Consolidate phase 2 and 3 skills.            Know trigraphs ear, ure, air.            Know vowel digraph er.            Read tricky words they, her, all, are.            Continue to apply knowledge of blending and segmenting to reading and spelling simple two-syllable words and captions.            Write more graphemes from memory and write a simple sentence using phonic knowledge.</p>
<b>Literacy</b>  <b>WRITING</b>  Emergent writing  Composition  Spelling  Handwriting	<p><b>Emergent writing:</b>            Continue to build on knowledge of letter sounds to build words in writing.            Use writing in play.            Use familiar words in their writing.</p> <p><b>Composition:</b>            Write a simple sentence with a full stop.</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b>            Spell words by drawing on knowledge of known grapheme correspondences.            Make phonetically plausible attempts when writing more complex unknown words.</p> <p><b>Handwriting:</b>            Form most lower-case letters correctly, starting and finishing in the right place, going the right way round and correctly orientated. Include spaces between words.</p>
<b>TFW Story Writing</b> <b>Development Focus</b>	<p>Child takes the pen more and more, until eventually they are writing complete phrases.            May still need a phonics mat to support.</p>
